



### 陳紫君 TK Chan

The artist studied design and worked in Scotland for 10 years. She misses Scotland and so began to paint Scottish scenes in Hong Kong. For TK, her paintings represent storybook romance.

Ms T.K. Chan graduated in MA Interdisciplinary Design from Edinburgh Napier University in 2007. She is co-founder and curator of BLINK Gallery. The works exhibited here are also collected in her illustration book, *The Reality of My Scotland*. She has exhibited in Hong Kong, London, Cardiff and Edinburgh. Her publications sold at the Edinburgh Fringe Office and Fruitmarket Gallery.

Upon Chan's return to Hong Kong, she began exploring interdisciplinary design and its potential for recording and exploring her experiences as a Hong Kong Chinese native living in Scotland, and her desire to promote Scottish culture in her home city.
